Fellow enthusiast,

This year the Magnum Rally turns 40!

The first Magnum Rally was held in August 1979. The event started on a Thursday at the Eastgate Shopping Mall Bruma area and travelled via Bethal, Hendrina and Carolina to Nelspruit where the event overnighted at the Shonalanga Hotel. The Friday was a free day and on Saturday the route took the competitors back to Eastgate. The first few Magnum events were generously sponsored by Magnum Airlines (the precursor to the current SA Air Link) – to such an extent that the event was able to build-up a reserve fund, which is currently held in trust by the POMC and is used to fund shortfalls in organising cost.

The first Magnum's were only open to Motorcycles and three wheelers manufactured on or before 31st December 1960.

To celebrate the 40th Magnum rally all entries with vehicles manufactured before 31st December 1960 will only pay half entry fee! For Motorcycles this will be funded out of the reserve funds for the Magnum while for Motorcars the POMC have made available an amount to cover the cost.

This year the event will again be held in the Mpumalanga area.

- Organised by the Pretoria Old Motor Club, you will experience magnificent scenery and enjoy some of the most beautiful mountain passes in the country. Special care has been taken to select the better roads in the area with cognisance of the prevailing traffic.
- Aside from the on-road experience, this three-day spider rally is hosted by fellow motoring enthusiast, Willem Fick, at his fabulous Hotel Numbi and Garden Suites, where he ensures that we receive the best accommodation, cuisine and service at the most unbelievably good rates

Supplementary Regulations (SR's)

1. NATURE AND NAME OF EVENT: A restricted event known as the 2019 Magnum Rally, incorporating:

The 40th Magnum Vintage and Classic Motorcycle Rally and the 12th Magnum Vintage and Classic Motor Car Rally.

2. **DATE OF EVENT:** Thursday,15th August to Saturday, 17th August 2019. Pre-Event scrutiny will be done at Hotel Numbi & Garden Suites, Hazyview, the centre of the "spider" event on Wednesday 14th and early morning Thursday 15th August 2018.

3. **DESCRIPTION OF EVENT:** A Reliability and Regularity Trial over a distance of approximately 800 km of which approximately 700 km will be regularity, comprising of five separate Score Groups, being:

Score Group A : For **motorcycles** manufactured on or before 31st December 1960.

Score Group B : For **motorcycles** manufactured between 1st January 1961 and 31st December 1997.

Score Group C : For **motorcars** manufactured before 31st December 1997.

Score Group D : For motorcars and motorcycles manufactured before 31st December 1997. Open

For the duration of the event, headquarters will be at the Hotel Numbi and Garden Suites, Hazyview. For accommodation and other facilities see Accommodation Form.

12. CLOSING DATE: Friday 05th July 2019.

Entry forms, full entry fee as well as the full accommodation fee, must be paid into the rally account not later than 5th July 2019. Details are indicated on the Entry and Financial and Accommodations forms,

The minimum number of entries is 40 and the maximum number is 70. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers. Accommodation at the venue is limited and will be available on a first come first served basis. See Financial & Accommodation Form attached.

13. **METHOD OF SETTING SPEEDS:** [See VSR 24] Speeds will be set in accordance with method 1 as defined in VSR 24(a). A choice of speed groups is offered on the entry form. The maximum speed for each speed group is as follows:

A: 55km/h B: 65km/h **C: 75**km/h **D: 90**km/h

14. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND STARTING TIMES: [See VSR 16] Competition numbers will be supplied by the organisers. Competitors are to supply their own backing boards.

All competitors will be required to display their assigned numbers on the <u>left side</u> and the <u>left front</u> (cars) of the vehicle. It is strongly recommended, that the front number be mounted above the headlight and not in front of it. Competition numbers and starting times will be advised in the final instructions.

15. **PASSENGERS:** See VSR 19.

16. **PRE-START REQUIREMENTS:** See VSR12 & VSR17. Any advertising material supplied by the organisers or sponsors shall be displayed on the vehicles as directed

The following additional requirements are applicable:

For motorcycles:

- The wearing of crash helmets is compulsory.
- Adequate protective clothing must be worn by competitors and we strongly recommend the following: boots, adequate eye protection, gloves and leathers, heavy-duty overalls, denims or heavy-duty trial suits.

For motorcars:

Seat belts to be used at all times, if fitted.

For motorcycles and motorcars:

- A GPS Data Logger, to be carried by the competitor, is to be presented to the chief scorer at documentation or as required in the Final Instructions. This instrument must be compatible with the software utilized by the organisers of the event. The onus is on the competitor to ensure that the battery is charged and that the GPS Data Logger is in working condition

Competitors are strongly advised to carry a spare logger, as in the event of a failure of the primary logger this will be used for the purpose of scoring

- 17. **PRE-START SCRUTINY AND DOCUMENTATION:** See VSRs 15 & 20. Documentation and pre-event scrutiny will be done at Hotel Numbi &Garden Suites, Hazyview, the centre of the "spider" event on Wednesday 14th between 10:00 and 19:00 and early morning Thursday 15th August 2018. Late arrivals on Wednesday, please make prior arrangements to have route schedules etc. put in rooms (if all other documentation requirements have been complied with). Limited Documentation and scrutiny facilities will be available on Thursday morning at the start.
- 18. **ROUTE SCHEDULES:** [See VSR 21] Route schedules will be as per VSR 21(b), will be pre-calculated and will be available, provided all documentation has been completed to the satisfaction of the organisers, on Wednesday (08-08-2018) for the first day and for the next two days after presentation of the score sheet for the current day [Attention is drawn to VSR 21(d).
- 19. TIME KEEPING AND CONTROLS: [See VSRs 26, 27 & 28]

Virtual controls will be used

VSR 26(a)(iv) Virtual Control – an unmanned control, not necessarily identified to competitors on the route schedule, the position of which is predetermined by GPS co-ordinates [latitude and longitude]. The competitors time of passing the control will be recorded by means of a GPS Data Logger carried in or upon the competing vehicle for the duration of the event.

Within thirty (30) minutes of each competitor's ETA at the end of each day, the competitor shall hand his GPS Data Logger to the Chief scorer. Failing to comply with this requirement will result in the competitor being classified a non-finisher for the day.

- 20. **INSTRUMENTS:** [See VSR 18] VSR18 (a) and (b) is not applicable to Score Group D. For all other Score Groups attention is drawn to the fact that under no circumstances is the use of any electronic devices for measuring speed or distance, such as GPS's, permitted during the event.
- 21. **RESULTS:** [See VSR 29]

In addition to VSR 29(a-d) after a competitor has presented his /her GPS Data Logger to the Chief scorer he/she will be given an individual detailed score sheet with ETA's, ATA's and errors expressed in seconds at all the virtual controls scored that day. This score sheet will be date and time stamped and the competitor will then have thirty (30) minutes to query his results. Thereafter his results will become final. After all competitors have received their score sheets and there are no outstanding queries, overall provisional results will be posted as follows:

Overall Provisional results will be announced at 18:30 on Saturday, 17-08-2019 at the rally venue.

Daily Provisional results, indicating errors per control, will be posted on the official notice board on the times indicated below or as soon as possible thereafter:

- 22. **PROTESTS:** See VSR 30.
- 23. **SCORING:** See VSR 28.

VSR 28(b)(iii): at all Virtual Controls, one penalty point for every second earlier or later than the official calculated ETA with a maximum of six hundred (600) penalty points

Add the following sub-clause (vi) to VSR 28(e): failure of the GPS Data Logger to be activated by the Global Positioning System at any Virtual control.

- 24. **PENALTIES:** See VSR 33
- 25. **POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION:** See VSR 9.
- 26. **REFUELLING:** The maximum distance between refuel points will not exceed 120km.
- 27. **TIE DOWNS:** Competitors must carry their own tie-downs to secure their motorcycles on the tender vehicle trailer in the event of a breakdown.
- 28. **VISITING PARTICIPANTS:** In Order to comply with the various regulations as set out in the VSRs, the Pretoria Old Motor Club has made provision for visiting participants, provided they are non-Residents of South Africa, to be made temporary members for the duration of the event.
- 29. **COMPETITION LICENCE:** A member in possession of a current valid membership card of any MSA affiliated or any SAVVA affiliated club is deemed to be in possession of a Restricted Competition Licence which mentions affiliation to SAVVA and has the inclusion of a Restricted Competition Licence. The Restricted Competition Licence is valid for SAVVA authorized events as well as for events hosted by MSA associated clubs requiring a Restricted Competition Licence. For this event it is required that the vehicle entered be dated by SAVVA and a Dating Certificate issued. Alternatively, the entrant should submit adequate proof that the vehicle complies with the eligibility conditions of entry
- 30. CLASSES, TROPHIES AND AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded as per the following rules and awards list.
- 30.1. The Floating Trophies may not leave the Republic of South Africa and remains the property of the organising club and are to be returned to the club. All trophies are to be engraved and returned by no later than 30th June 2020. Only finishers will qualify for trophies. The organisers reserve the right to increase or reduce the number of trophies/awards or to change the basis of awarding trophies/awards. Starters medallions will be awarded to all starters in Score Groups A, B, C and D.
